July 17, 2007

The fifty-second meeting of the West Virginia University Board of Governors was held on July 17, 2007, by telephone conference call. CALL TO ORDER

BOARD ITEMS

Effective August 1, 2007, operations of the University would shift to Mr. Garrison; effective September 1, 2007, President Hardesty would relinquish the presidency to Mr. Garrison. After discussion, Mr. Barnette moved the approval of these revisions. The motion was seconded, and carried unanimously.
